MAIN TAKEAWAY

God doesn't want us just to survive, but to thrive—He wants us to be ALL IN. An all-in faith moves from passive belief to active trust, where faith is not a feeling you have but a discipline you do.

INTRODUCTION

Share about an experience when you were at the right place at the right time. Why is church the right place to be as we end one year and begin another?

While many consider their health, finances, and goals at the beginning of a New Year, why is it most important to evaluate your faith?

UNDERSTANDING

READ HEBREWS 11:1-2, 6

All-in faith knows who you belong to. In what way is faith the proof of God's ownership of His people (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)? What is the difference between viewing hope as wishful thinking or as a confident expectation in God's promises?

All-in faith is up to the test. In a world of spiritual fakes, how can we tell when faith is authentic? When tested, what is the difference between genuine and fake faith?

All-in faith pleases God. Pastor Adam Eaton said, "God is not looking for perfection; He is looking for trust." What do you think impresses God? How is this different from how we try to impress others?

READ HEBREWS 11:32-12:2

All-in faith is possible. Hebrews 11 is the highlight reel of the "Hall of Faith," such as Noah, Abraham, and Moses. How does this list illustrate that faith is not about being perfect, but about being available to say yes to God?

All-in faith goes the distance. In what way is faith more like a marathon than a sprint? How do those who have gone before you—the cloud of witnesses in Hebrews 11, church history, and your relationships—inspire you to run the race of faith?

All-in faith looks to Jesus. To finish the race, we must rip off every weight, run with endurance, and know where to look. How does the truth that Jesus was all in for you (through His perfect life, sacrificial death, and victorious resurrection) enable you to be all in for Him?

APPLICATION

Pastor Adam said that many people use faith like an insurance policy—it's there in case they need it. How has faith changed the way you live, moving you from belief to action—do you live as though Heaven is real, death isn't the end, and you're forgiven?

Pastor Adam said, "If you stare at your problems, you will be distracted; if you look to Jesus, your problems will have perspective." How do you practically look to Jesus?

In what way is an "all-in faith" simply the faith that God requires of all His people? How did this message shape your perspective about true faith as you reflect on the past year and plan for the New Year?
